

Pleasant Hill Fall Mixed Doubles Round Robin League's

League Format:

1. 10 Teams utilizing 5 Courts. (20 players)
2. Registration is by teams of 2 (1 man, 1 woman)
3. Teams Play every other team in the league once over the first 5 weeks of the season.
4. Play can start as early as 5:00 but needs to start by 5:30 to complete matches prior to sunset.
5. Teams will play 2 matches per week.
 - 5.1. Each match is the first team to win two games. (3 Games max)
 - 5.1.1. Games will be played to 11 and you must win by 2.
 - 5.1.2. Each team is assured to play at least 4 games per week.
 - 5.2. Each game won awards one point to the winning team.
 - 5.2.1. All the matches will therefore end with scores of 2-0 or 2-1.
 - 5.3. All teams will be given a list of the following during week 1 of play.
 - 5.3.1. All the teams in the league contact information.
 - 5.3.2. The full league schedule.
 - 5.3.3. The court assignments for each match
6. The points awarded through the Round Robin play will determine the standings and matchups for week 6. Week 6 will be the league playoff matches and will be the best 3 out of 5 games to determine final standings.
 - 6.1. Head-to-head matches will be used as a tie breaker if needed.
 - 6.1.1. 1 vs 2, 3 vs 4, 5 vs 6, 7 vs 8, 9 vs 10.
7. If a team cannot make it to play on league night, it is their responsibility to contact the other teams they are scheduled to play.
 - 7.1.1. They can arrange to play those matches at another time outside of league play or inform the team they are scheduled to play that they need to forfeit the match.
 - 7.1.1.1. Forfeited matches will result in the opposing team to be awarded 2 points.
 - 7.1.2. All rescheduled matches must be completed prior to week 5 of the league or during week 5 when teams will only be scheduled to play one match.
 - 7.1.2.1. Only one match per team can be made up in week 5.
 - 7.1.3. Teams will be allowed to name a substitute for a player that gets injured or must miss multiple weeks due to unforeseen circumstances.
8. All USA Pickleball rules will be used to govern games.
 - 8.1. All games will be self-officiated.
 - 8.2. Good Sportsmanship is the number one rule to always keep in mind.
